Working principally with paper and encaustic medium, both of which have been used in art making for millennia, Katherine explores the characteristics of sculptural forms via casting, carving, pouring and shaping. Her interest, however, is in extending and expanding their characteristics to carry these processes further. Katherine's work is found in the collections of Museum of Women in the Arts, Washington, DC; Museum of Arts and Design, New York; Sara and David Lieberman Collection of Contemporary Baskets; and the Gloria and Sonny Kamm Foundation.
